K-9 Officers, Matt Sloan and Andy Kalet gave a presentation to the board members regarding K-9 searches and how they work in the school environment. An investigator will conduct part two of the investigation end at the July 24, 2017 Regular Meeting.

Math Minute – Mike Wurster

Middle School Principal, Mike Wurster gave the board their first "math minute" update on what the middle school math department is working on. His math team was in on July 5th and reviewed the new standards that will take effect in the 2018-2019 school year. They reviewed differences in gaps, overlaps and the new "next generation math", which was formerly common core and noted that they do align. Students will need to learn and become familiar with some new math glossary terms and they plan to work on the "next generation" pieces after state testing in the spring. *Imagine Math* representatives came to Cayuga Elementary recently and they are excited that the program can be used as a supplemental intervention math tool for students.
