

SUBJECT: BROADCASTING AND TAPING OF BOARD MEETINGS

The Board of Education recognizes its responsibility to allow community access to public portions of its meetings. The public portion of any Board meeting may be photographed, recorded and/or broadcast, unless it is obtrusive, disruptive, or interferes with the deliberative process or the right of persons in attendance to observe or listen to the proceedings.

If any person in attendance requests that photographing, recording or broadcasting of a public portion of the meeting should be interrupted due to disruption, interference or obtrusiveness, it shall be the responsibility of the Board President to render a decision on such request.

This policy shall be posted in a designated public location. Written copies of such policy shall be provided upon request, free of charge, to those in attendance at or who seek to attend a meeting.
