SUBJECT: POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE BOARD

The Board is the governing body of the District. It possesses those powers expressly delegated by statute or necessarily and reasonably implied therefrom. The general powers and duties of school boards are outlined in the New York State Education Law. Consistent with this law, the School Board has the authority and duty to adopt whatever policies, rules and bylaws they deem will best meet their statutory responsibilities and secure the best education results for the students of the District.
